


GUIDE

To start a Route Log, select Log Data from the Guide screen and follow the 4-step on screen instructions.







ROUTE LOG


To end a Route Log, select Log Data from the Guide screen. Scroll down to follow the 3-step on screen instructions.


REGISTERING RETURN LOCATIONS

REVIEWING YOUR ACTIVITY LOG

Select Route Log from the menu at the bottom of the screen, and then select All Activity to see your logged data. Once selected, your Activity List will appear.





Logged points from your selected route will detail altitude, coordinates, time and distance.








You can also view every logged point over time, regardless of the route. To do so, select the Point tab in the upper right on the Activity List screen. This list will show all registered points including time, date and altitude.


STEP TRACKER

WORLD TIME


Select World Time at the menu at the bottom of the screen to update your world time city.

UTILITY


Select Utility from the menu at the bottom of the screen to set alarms, time signal, and operate the timer.



ADDITIONAL WATCH SETTINGS

Additional options that can be adjusted by the app are listed here. This makes updating settings easier.

At the bottom of this menu is the Disconnect button. This will unpair the watch from the phone. The watch can only be paired to one device at a time so if you need to change devices, complete this step first.

The app stores all of the watch data, even after disconnecting the watch. You may reconnect the watch at any time.

Removing the app from your device will delete all saved watch data and settings preferences.
